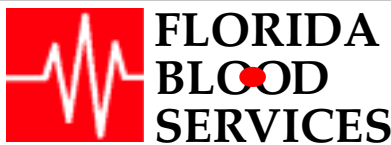

COUPONS COUPONS COUPONS FOR ACTIVE DUTY SOLDIERS LIVING OVERSEAS

Holiday Isles Elks Lodge #1912 is joining with Largo Lodge # 2159 in collecting **MANUFACTURER COUPONS** for use by active duty military families stationed overseas. Did you know that more than 12,000 of our military families stationed overseas rely on food stamps and the help they get from home or, friends, churches or other organizations in order to meet their daily needs FYI, in April of this year, Largo Lodge# 2159 sent \$23,716 worth of coupons to the Ramstein, Germany military base for use at that local Commissary.

The coupons we collect will be sent to active duty overseas bases for the families to use at their local Commissary; currently, the Ramstein Military Base families are the recipients of this project. In the future and if feasible, this effort may be extended to include other military branches and bases. The coupons you donate will be valid up to 6 months after the initial expiration date.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR BUNDLING YOUR COUPONS:

1. Cut out your coupons and group them into food and non-food packets and place them in separate envelopes. Personally, I have added two additional categories for organizing my coupons; I have added: Babies and Pets.
2. Organize your coupons into the following groups: Food, Non-Food, Baby and Pets and place them in envelopes marked Food, Non-Food, Baby or Pets.
3. If possible, please count the total number of coupons you are donating on your envelope, and if you would, - please and thank you - total the value amount of each group and write those numbers on the front of your donation envelope.
4. There will be collection buckets in the Lobby of our Lounge/Bar and Dining Room area for you to drop off any manufacturer coupons that you wish to donate. Old envelopes from junk mail are a great way to use to save your coupons as they are free and will help to contribute to our new "green environment".

Our Lodge, Holiday Isles, will run the coupon collection effort from September through December of 2011. If you have questions or need any more information, or help in bundling your coupons, contact Linda Kufro, Chaplain of our Lodge, at 727-641-2726. The Largo Lodge project leaders are Ron and Pat Kellner. Thanks for your help.

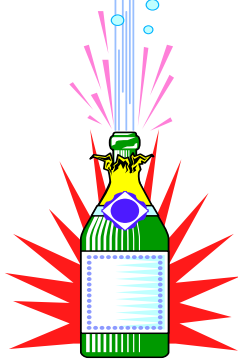

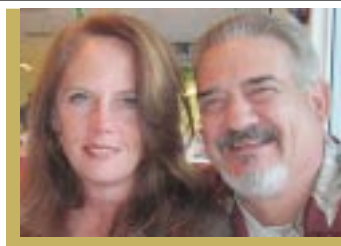

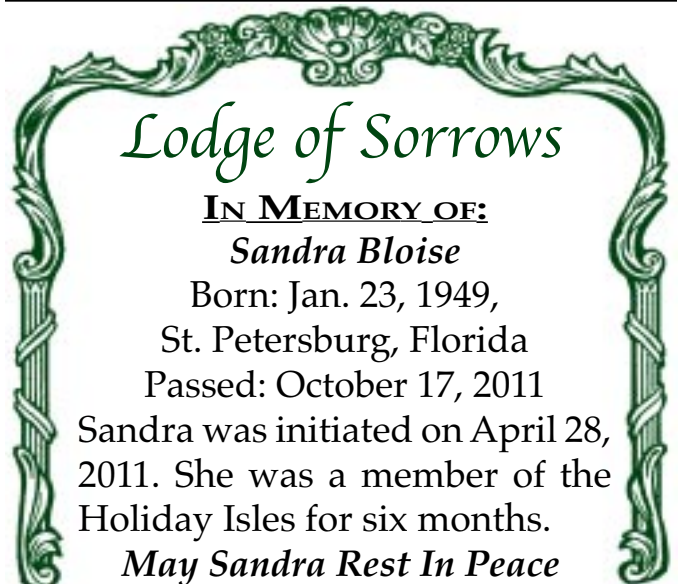
